


Collaboration in action (2012 – 2018)




Number of Founders



National LGPS Frameworks do this








Creating a National LGPS Framework

- Identifying Requirement
- Finding Founders
- Market Research / Engagement
- Prior Information Notice published
- Contract Notice then published
- Invitation to Tender issued which includes:
 - Specification of requirements
 - Final Terms and Conditions
 - Fee/pricing schedule
- Deadline for submission of clarification questions
- Deadline for submission of tenders (this is usually about a week after the final clarification date)
- Contract Award and standstill
- Service Commencement

How it works for users

- Contact National LGPS Frameworks
- Introduction Pack containing:
 - Introduction Notes
 - Confidentiality Statement
 - Sample Members Access Agreement
- Return Confidentiality Statement
 - Before receiving Provider's catalogues and pricing structures Funds are required to sign and return a Confidentiality Agreement
- Once a decision is made to utilise the Framework a Members Access Agreement is signed.







Key benefits for users

- Lower prices and shortened timescales, but also...
- Agreed Terms and Conditions of contract
- Comprehensive user documentation
- Easier for the LGPS to access wider range of service providers
- Cumulative rebates



- Agreed Terms and Conditions of contract
- Standard consistent process with standard tender documents provided to funds
- Shortened timescale for Procurement = new business known quicker
- Encouragement from central Government to use the frameworks.
- Managed framework continuity
- Easier for Funds and Pools to access and know about providers


